Keith Michael Schlichte, 59, of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, passed away on Sunday, August 1, 2021, at his father's home in Cedar Rapids. A Funeral Liturgy will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, August 7, 2021, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Marion, Iowa, conducted by Deacon Jeff Volker, where the family will greet friends one hour prior to the service.
